

## SECTION 00 10 00 – INVITATION TO BID

NOTICE: The Kittitas Reclamation District (“District”) hereby gives notice that it will accept sealed Bids for the construction of the South Branch Canal Lining – Swede to Robinson Creek project (“Project”).

### PART 1 – GENERAL

#### 1.01 BID SUBMISSION

The District will receive sealed Bids at the location listed below until **2:00 p.m. local time on August 23, 2019**, and will then and there open and publicly read the Bids for the construction of the improvements.

Submit all Bids in accordance with the procedures set forth in Section 00 20 00 (Instructions to Bidders).

#### 1.02 WORK DESCRIPTION

Bid improvements consist of concrete lining, drainage, earthwork and other work, all in accordance with the contract plans, the contract provisions, and the specifications. The improvements are for construction of water conservation and operational improvements to the KRD system. Requested base bid and pre-priced optional work follow the existing South Branch Canal alignment for a distance of approximately 2.9 miles from Robinson Creek up to the Swede Tunnel outlet. The Project has been divided into 5 distinct Reaches with Reach 1 lining having been completed. The base bid improvements in these documents are for canal lining of the Reach 2 Milestone described as work related to canal lining and improvements between Stations 485+00 downstream and Station 472+25 along with access and fencing improvement for both Reach 1 and Reach 2.

It is the District’s desire to line the remaining reaches of the canal upstream of Station 472+25 within two construction seasons. Pricing of the additional Reach 3, Reach 4, and Reach 5 is requested for potential optional award at the discretion of KRD. Optional award will depend on a variety of factors, including, but not limited to, weather, cost, Contractors work plan, demonstrated productivity on Reach 2, and the anticipated start of the 2020 and 2021 irrigation seasons on or about April 1 of each associated year. This optional pricing will not be factored into evaluation of apparent low bidder.

#### 1.03 CONTRACT TIME

Contract time shall begin as defined by the Notice to Proceed and proceed through completion in accordance with Section 00 73 00 (Supplementary Conditions). Anticipated award and Notice to Proceed to allow for construction during the annual canal outage beginning in fall 2019.

#### 1.04 BID INSTRUCTIONS

Refer to Section 00 20 00 (Instructions to Bidders) for required documents and items to be included with sealed Bids submitted to the District for the construction of the improvements.

1.05 REGISTRATION AND PROCUREMENT OF BIDDING DOCUMENTS

1.06 BID PREPARATION COSTS

Bidders are solely responsible for the cost of preparing their Bids.

1.07 RESERVATION OF RIGHTS

The District specifically reserves the right, in its sole discretion, to reject any or all Bids or re-Bids or to waive inconsequential deviations from Bid requirements not involving time, price, or work quality.
